STUDENT CHECKLIST

WHAT I NEED TO DO BEFORE COMING TO CAMPUS

- Complete the mandatory <u>COVID-19 awareness training</u> on Mosaic.
- Visit MacCheck online starting September 7.
- Upload proof of vaccination to our digital tool MacCheck. All students must upload proof of vaccination between September 7 and October 18. More details in our <u>FAO</u>. Information on exemptions can be found <u>here</u>.
- If you are not fully vaccined, <u>you must get tested</u> to come to a McMaster location or off-site affiliate location.
- Complete the COVID-19 health screening on MacCheck in the hour prior to leaving for campus.
- Bring with you:
 - ☐ A mask or face covering; and
 - ☐ Your student ID card if you need a new or replacement card, here's instructions for students.
- Plan for how you'll get to campus, including <u>applying for or renewing a parking pass</u>, <u>researching public transit schedules</u> or looking into bike racks and secure bike storage options.
- Review the <u>Principles and Practices for an Inclusive Community</u>.
- Review the <u>Back to Mac website</u> for additional information and safety meaures.

WHAT I NEED TO DO WHILE ON CAMPUS
