UPDATE: COVID-19 Health & Safety Changes

- As of June 1, McMaster's <u>masking mandate</u> is paused, but masking is strongly encouraged, especially in indoor settings
- The <u>Vaccination Mandate</u> for staff, faculty, students and visitors will continue to be paused
- We strongly encourage our community to get vaccinated and stay up to date on the boosters they are eligible to receive, and upload these to MacCheck.
- MacCheck is no longer required, but daily <u>provincial health screening</u> is required
- Stay at home if you're feeling unwell
- University employees need to report through Mosaic if they test positive for COVID-19 and have been on site within the last 14 days. Students do not have to report cases
- The <u>public dashboard</u> of reported cases on the Back to Mac website will be paused as of June 1
- Students, staff and faculty are required to <u>complete COVID-19</u> <u>awareness training.</u>
- Learners, staff and faculty in off-site locations, including hospital sites, must follow the requirements of the site
